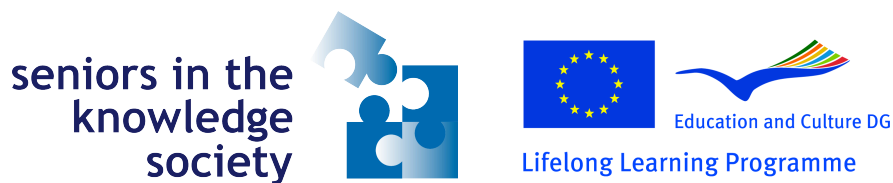

Title	Internet Guide
Institution	University Centre Zvolen (UCZ)
Short description	<p>Group of learners will create a short leaflet (2 pages) in English for seniors who do not use Internet to attract them and to show them in simple way how to use it.</p> <p>What will be leaflet about? First steps with Internet:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Browsers – what are browsers and how to use them • Websites – what are websites and how to use them. What are the most known websites and what are their advantages (for example: www.google.com) • Communication through Internet (e-mail, Skype, ICQ) • Social websites (Facebook, Twitter)
Resources	Computers with internet connection.
Aims	To motivate other seniors to use Internet and to learn them what advantages it can bring into their lives.
Development	This leaflet can be delivered other seniors and help them to learn how to use Internet. Include our seniors into ICT society.

Title	WORKSHOP: Interactive board
Institution	U3A University of Life Sciences Prague lecturer: Jiri Votava, Ph.D.
Short description	Interactive board for all ages, this course is aimed at seniors students with lower level of ICT knowledge, course can be held in English
Resources	Study materials of the Institute of Education and Communication, documents to be used on the interactive board
Aims	Senior learners will acquire a new ICT tool in the classroom. They will get

	familiar with the different tools of the interactive board (pen, rubber, moving of the objects, compatibility with other programmes...)
Development	After theoretical presentation of this tool, they will be able work with the interactive board. They will work in pairs on the given task during this workshop.
More info	One of the topic which will be discovered on the interactive board will be the virtual art gallery. We suggest having this workshop in Prague, because we do not know, if there will be any other possibility of using this tool during other meetings of Seniors KS project.

Title	Creating in a BLOG
Institution	OEH Uni Graz
Short description	A group of learners and professors will be able to create a blog. The blog contents can be a documentary of the conference days including the city of Prague.
Resources	Computers with internet connection, webmail access (please remember your webmail password!!)
Aims	To understand what a blog is useful for and how it can be created and accessed easily (creating blog posts, uploading photos, etc. To understand blogging as a reflective web 2.0 tool
Development	We will be looking at blogs in the internet to get a taste of this tool. Learners then will create their own blog and will be able to present it (if they want)
