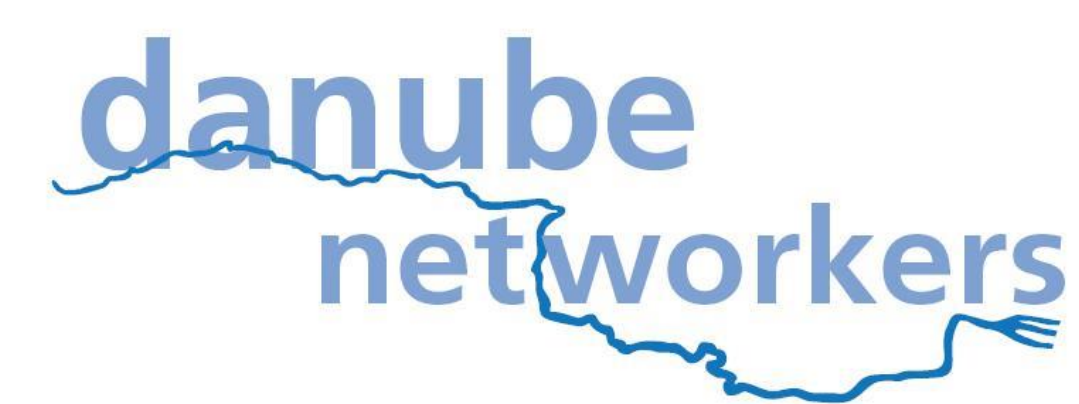




ZAWiW of Ulm University
